

Regrettably, due to rising costs for food, utilities and vet bills we have had to re-evaluate the donation we ask for when re-homing our dogs and cats. We now have 2 tiers for re-homing as follows

## Dog

Under 6 months of age	£155
Over 6 months of age	£135

## Cat

Under 6 months of age	£105
Over 6 months of age	£85

We would like to give you an idea of what it costs us to care for these animals, so you can see why we ask for these donations.

Often animals come in having had no vaccinations, flea or worm treatment or un-neutered. As a charity we fund all of this treatment and often the rehoming donation does not cover these costs.

You will see from above the re-homing donation often does not cover the basic treatments. We frequently have to carry out other treatments such as dentals which increases costs more. It also costs us between £5 and £7 per day to take care of these animals.

This is why we have taken the unfortunate decision to increase the requested re-homing donation.
