



Role Purpose

Worcestershire Animal Rescue Shelter in Malvern takes in abandoned, unwanted and mistreated animals in need of urgent care. Our aim is to re-home our animals as quickly and safely as possible to provide them with loving forever homes.

Our busy Shelter is looking for a reliable individual to help keep our grounds and gardens in a tidy and weed free state as well as look after the ad-hoc maintenance of our internal and external buildings.

Main Responsibilities

- To help maintain the grounds of the Shelter, to keep tidy and safe for staff, animals and visitors;
- Utilising lawn mowers, strimmers and other gardening tools supplied by the Shelter to mow the site, trim edges, weed pathways and borders and around playpens together with maintaining the coppice area;
- Identifying and reporting potential hazards or faults on site in order to maintain a safe environment;
- Ensuring tools and equipment are maintained in a good, workable condition;
- Maintenance and ad-hoc DIY to maintain the interior and exterior of the buildings on site;
- Providing a professional, courteous and customer friendly approach.
- To provide a regular commitment for a minimum of three months and work a minimum of 6 hours per week over 1 or 2 days (Mon-Sun).

Required Skills & Experience

- Experience of undertaking general gardening duties and building maintenance;
- Confidence with using garden machinery (full training will be given);
- A general awareness of Health and Safety;
- You will need to be physically fit as we have a 6½ acre site;
- Good interpersonal and customer service skills together with a proactive and positive attitude to working tasks with the ability to prioritise workload.
